Services for women, children & families

WIC (Women Infants and Children)

"WIC is for Working Families"

This program is a nutrition education and counseling program for pregnant women, breastfeeding women, infants, and children up to age 5 may qualify. It also offers health education and referral. For more information contact the Oneida County WIC Program at (715)369-6109.

Prenatal Care Coordination

This program is offered to pregnant women who receive medical assistance, Badgercare or Healthy Start. A registered nurse offers personal support, pregnancy education and counseling, and assistance in finding needed resources. For more information call 369-6107.

Breastfeeding Support & Resources

A breastfeeding educator is available for breastfeeding support as well as lending library, pump purchase, and breastfeeding resources. For more information call 369-6186

Services for Men & Women

Wisconsin Well-Women Program

This program provides health services for women between the ages of 35-64 with low income, no insurance or not enough insurance. For more information call 369-6118.



Reproductive Health Clinic

This program provides reproductive health screening services including :

- STD Screening & Treatment
- Pap & Pelvic Examinations
- Pregnancy Testing
- Emergency Contraception
- Family Planning Services
