<u>Review</u> & <u>Updates</u>	<p>1.) Review of last month's meeting minutes and agenda sent out for today's meeting.</p> <p>2.) <u>Review the SurveyMonkey results</u>: 10 people answered the Survey Monkey out of 36 members.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 50% would like to be active members and 50% wanted to continue as informational only members. • 80% had some AODA background and 20% were AODA professionals. • All were interested in Rx Drug Abuse, 89% were interested in Under Age Drinking, 66% are interested in drug trends and 24% were interested in law enforcement issues. • 77% are interested in developing community partnerships, 66% want to plan AODA Coalition activities, 55% want to work on media releases, 33% want to work with youth, 11% want to work with legislators to make environmental change. 	<p>1.) Last meeting was January 27th, 2014. Corrections were made and minutes will be posted on website.</p> <p>3.) Discussion followed on when and how often we need the AODA Coalition to meet to reach our goals. Sub-committee work can be done as often as the workgroup feels is necessary. (ie, PWH may meet a few times to coordinate efforts, or may decide to meet via phone or emails). Also the Mental Health Coalition is also looking at how often they meet. Many members are on both committees. Lynn Feldman made a motion to reduce the numbers of AODA Coalition meeting by ½ and to meet on the opposite months that the Mental Health Coalition meets, (if the Mental Health Coalition also meets less often). Dawn K, seconded. <i>Let the record show that all approved.</i> Next motion Lynn Feldman made was to change the AODA By-Laws for the meeting times to be the 4th Monday of every other month; (Feb., April, June, August, October & December) and to start at 10:30 am and end at noon. They have developed the materials to use for the promotion of the <i>KNOW!</i> Project and will have this information available to the community at clinic waiting rooms, etc. They will present their community awareness plan at the March 6th meeting. Lynn is also working on getting her <i>Prevention Specialist Certification</i> required for this grant. 2.) Donna Shimeck was here today to explain how the first year of the RX ABUSE prevention grant went. She is hoping to hire a full time AODA counselor (vs. the part time position that was originally offered). Chris Hatlep is the interim lead supervisor and he is the OWI court counselor and will be invited to attend our meetings in the future. Donna is working on a future training on Rx Drug Abuse with Wayne Sorenson. They are hoping to get Flo Hillard here for the training. 3.) Oneida County Mental Health Summit is on May 11th. The theme is COMPASSION and MINISTRY MEDICAL is now helping with the coordination of the event including the registration. There may be charges for the display tables. (Katie will check on this.)
