<b>Updates</b>	<p><b><u>A.) AODA Coalition five year work plan objectives:</u></b></p> <p>Jeff shared the draft of the next five year work plan that Linda Conlon, Director of the Health Dept., Erica Brewster, UW-EX and his workgroup has developed. The outline is as follows:            Goal #1 – Improve access and availability of a full spectrum of substance abuse policies and programs including prevention.            Goal #2 – Decrease alcohol for underage youth            Goal #3 - Decrease abuse and diversion of prescription drugs            Goal #4 - Participate in comprehensive coalition-building</p> <p>They are also working with the Mental Health group to combine strategies for future work plans.</p> <p><b><u>B.) Parent Networks:</u></b></p> <p>Jim was able to present the <b>Parent Network</b> idea to the <i>Nativity of Our Lord</i> School Board and they were very interested in pursuing this in the future. They would likely work at the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade level. Jim is planning on contacting the other private school, <i>Zion Lutheran</i> to see if they are also interested in creating a Parent Network in the Fall of 2011.</p> <p><b><u>C.) Parents Who Host update:</u></b></p> <p>Anne gave Kathy M. update about how the letters from the Oneida County DA were sent out to the Rhinelander and Three Lakes High school seniors families prior to graduation. The school system put the mailing labels on the envelopes and the AODA coalition will pay for the postage and printing of the letters. Jeff said the Administration Board plan is to include law enforcement strategies for AODA issues at the policy level.</p> <p><b><u>D.)
