<b>UPDATES:</b>		
<b>CHIP 5 yr plan</b>	Jeff Knudson said that Erica Brewster is working on the final work plan for the OCHD Community Health Improvement Five year plan (2012-2016). Erica will be invited to the next meeting to review this plan for us. AODA Coalition members have been given time to get their suggestions to Linda Conlon and Erica B. The next CHIP will incorporate collaboration with the Mental Health Coalition too. They are also adding a new CHRONIC DISEASE section.	
<b>Member Capacity</b>	<p>Jeff K. led a discussion on how to increase participation in the AODA Coalition meetings. Many people are working on AODA issues but aren't attending the meetings to provide updates. It was suggested that a letter be sent to the AODA Coalition <i>current</i> members to survey why that are not at the meetings. Also to encourage participation by having a return postcard with information on how (and if) they want to participate in the next five year plan. We need more people from local business community and law enforcement at our meetings.</p> <p>PSA's for monthly AODA calendar of events was suggested. <b>Northwoods Coalition Update</b>	Jeff K. passed out the Marshfield Clinic Center's Community Outreach Positive Alternatives Coalition 8-11 update. In it, it describes the Northwoods Coalition (NWC) Lakeland Area Rx Drug Task Force initiative. A meeting is in the works to investigate how the Task Force will interface with the pharmacies.	
<b>Get the MEDS OUT project</b>	Anne demonstrated the "Get the Meds" out program that the Oneida County Health Department along with the Department of Aging and area pharmacies are working on. This UW Extension grant provides pre-paid envelopes for people to mail in their old medications for proper disposal. There is no limit to the number of times you can use this program. It was developed to help residents tin counties whose watershed empty into the Great Lakes.	Anne Cirilli
