NEW BUISNESS ITEM added to agenda: Two <i>KwickTrip</i> stores with liquor licenses in Rhinelander in near future.</p> <p>2. <u>Conference Updates</u>:</p>	<p>Mr. Stein attended today's meeting as a concerned citizen to discuss the increased opportunity for youth to obtain beer at these types of gas stations. Police Chief Steffas had discussed his concern for the need to do "vendor compliance checks" with the new owners. The AODA Coalition will develop a fact sheet with talking points to present to the Rhinelander City Council meeting on Dec. 10<sup>th</sup>, opposing adding more liquor licenses in the city. Erica B. will work with Katie Leone to create this fact sheet. AODA members will be urged to attend the City Council meeting and/or contact their city council representatives before the meeting. "Letters to the Editor" are also encouraged. It was suggested that we create a "Proclamation" and sign it electronically to present to the City Council by Monday, December 10<sup>th</sup>.</p> <p>Anne C. and Katie Leone attended the <i>Human Trafficking</i> workshop held earlier this week at Holiday Acres. Anne gave an overview and a scenario of how some women who are in the drug culture environment are coerced into a life of exploitation. Workshop attendees were given the PowerPoint presentations on a USB drive and it is available through Anne at the Health Department if you want to view any of the presentations.</p>

Anne C. manned the AODA Coalition station and discussed the Oneida County AODA Coalition work over the last year. There was a display that highlighted the <i>HEP C cluster outbreak</i> that was reported in the CDC <u><i>Mortality &amp; Morbidity Weekly Review (MMWR)</i></u> about Northern Wisconsin drug use of people under the age of 30.</p> <p>Tony Albright commented that the recent HIV increase is also connected to the increase in drug use. There may be future grant money available to add this to our 2013 AODA Coalition Work plan.</p> <p>Bob Kovar was not able to attend today to give us a report. Kelly Schoen did attend the PAC &amp; NORDAG meetings recently. She is replacing Jeff Knudson from OPTIONS and is learning the different AODA treatment and prevention services available in Northern Wisconsin. Kelly is originally from Madison WI.</p> <p>Katie L. attended the Lakeland RX Drug Taskforce meeting on Nov.19<sup>th</sup> in Minocqua. She gave a report on how the meeting went. Bob Kovar was featured on Channel 12 news this week to inform the public on the taskforce's goals. There may be funding coming from the CDC for Coalitions to work on some of these goals, such as working on a statewide data base. Oneida County was listed as the 8<sup>th</sup> county slated for the funding <i>if it is available</i>. We should hear by the beginning of December.....watch your emails.</p> <p>Katie worked on a fact sheet, similar in design to the PWH factsheet, which we can distribute to youth and their parents at future parent network meetings.
