Old Business:  Review	<p>1. Rhinelander City Council petition and public hearing on allowing alcohol licenses for gas stations within city limits update:</p> <p>2. Northwoods Coalition Update:</p>	<p>The proclamation/petition was sent prior to the Rhinelander City Council meeting on Dec. 10th to re-consider their plans on allowing more liquor licenses in the city of Rhinelander. At that meeting, it was decided to hold a public hearing on January 14<sup>th</sup> at 6pm. AODA Coalition members are encouraged to attend. Katie and Erica will draft a “Letter to the Editor” that highlights our concerns and issues on this subject. AODA members will be able to preview the letter before it is sent to the newspapers. Erica B. had a discussion with Rhinelander Police Chief, Mike Steffes to approve alcohol compliance checks <i>if</i> the City decides to allow alcohol at gas stations. <i>If</i> the ordinance is changed to allow alcohol at gas stations, then we need to make sure that alcohol “tasting events” are not allowed.</p> <p>The Oneida County AODA Coalition will host the Northern Region meeting on February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2013. Places to hold this event were discussed. Anne C. will call the Law Enforcement Center on Chippewa Drive to see if it can be held there. Julia Sherman is developing “Tool Kits” for community coalitions to work in their communities to establish compliance checks.</p>

Adolescent Brain Development fact sheet update:</p>	<p>SAMSHA is awarding grant contracts to 9 counties in Wisconsin to deal with RX drug abuse. This contract will go to the Human Services Department to cover Oneida and Forest Counties. This three year contract is worth (est.) \$225, 000.00. It will allow for counties to develop a statewide drug surveillance system and allow for outcome evaluation data to be reviewed.
