<b><u>Updates</u></b>	1.) <u>Lac du Flambeau Wellness Court</u> :  2.) <u>Legislative Update</u> :  3.) <u>Vilas County Youth Day</u> :	1.) Bob Kovar reported that the LdF Wellness Court is doing well and their goal was to provide guidance to 10 people this first year. They have three individuals already being helped since August, 2013.  2.) The State of WI legislation amendment to change the language of control substances for “misbranding” use i.e., “not intended for human consumption”.  3.) Lynn Feldman attended the Vilas County Youth Day which was an outside event to explore <i>Positive Alternatives</i> to high risk behaviors for 6 <sup>th</sup> graders in Vilas County. She presented on <i>Restorative Justice</i> and Sara Gardner talked on <i>Alcohol and Drug Abuse</i> . Most presentations were 20 minutes long, but she thought the AODA presentation could have been twice as long to cover all the topics well. She felt it was a worthwhile experience for the students.

Lynn Feldman at UW-Extension will attend the Nov. 14<sup>th</sup> meeting and report back to the AODA Coalition with ideas for future strategic planning.</p> <p>b.) Lynn is also attending the “Drug Identification” training on November 18<sup>th</sup> at Lake of the Torches Convention Center.</p> <p>c.) The Northern Coalition is looking into providing ARIDE (Advance Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement) trainings. ARIDE was developed by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration to train officer how to identify and assess drivers suspected of being under the influence of alcohol and other drugs.</p> <p>The next <i>annual</i> Northwoods Regional Coalition meeting will be held on June 24<sup>th</sup> &amp; 25<sup>th</sup>, 2014.</p> <p>2.) Anne C. reported that the Rhinelander Police Department recovered over 200 pounds of unused prescription medications on Saturday, Oct. 26<sup>th</sup>.
