Stephanie will be out of a job.</p> <p>Jodie Harris: Has been working on the Clinics public health accreditation, moved to work on this more than BF but they have been able to get their Clinics BF policy sign in BF support, throughout the tribal buildings for all employees; except the Casino. Forest Co. Potawatomi Health & Wellness Center is supporting the Secrets of Baby Behavior with \$500. Thank You!!!</p> <p>Sami Hoffman: Is continuing to work on bf duration, FC WIC BF incidence still above 80%; BF at 6 mos at about 60%.
