#### History:

Started in 2003 as an Influenza Coalition working on coordinating influenza and pandemic response. In 2003 there was a pertussis outbreak that required intensive follow up and coordination with providers and local health departments.

In 2005 the group evolved into the Northwood's Communicable Disease Coalition mainly to address communication gaps with providers and provide better follow up for communicable disease. The group also focused on improving county immunization rates, staff education and community education relating to immunizations.

2006 Immunization Update with CDC speaker, Coordinated a community wide influenza response with media release and sharing flu vaccine inventory status.

2007 Successful in getting providers to use the immunization schedules recommended by ACIP. In 2010, the group changed the name to Northwood's Immunization Coalition because another group called Syndromic Surveillance was developed with a focus on addressing communicable disease issues.
